How Optical Splitters Work

An optical splitter is a passive device that divides a single input optical signal into multiple output signals, distributing light to several fibers without requiring power . The main fiber carries the upstream signal from the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) to the splitter, which then distributes it to multiple Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) or user endpoints . The splitter's performance depends on proper alignment, waveguide integrity, and mechanical stability .

Consequences of Disconnecting the Main Fiber

- **Complete Signal Loss:** If the main input fiber is disconnected, no light enters the splitter. As a result, all output fibers receive no optical signal, leading to a total service outage for all users connected downstream .
- **Network Alarms:** In a PON, the OLT will detect the absence of optical power and trigger alarms, indicating that multiple ONTs are offline . This helps network operators quickly identify the disruption.
- **No Partial Functionality:** Unlike minor splitter degradation or output imbalance, disconnecting the main fiber affects all outputs simultaneously. Even if the splitter itself is intact, the lack of input prevents any signal distribution .
