

What interface is the switch s access point

An access point is typically connected to a switch via an access port, often configured with the appropriate VLAN and sometimes using Power over Ethernet (PoE).

Access Port Connection

The switch interface that connects to an access point is usually an access port, which is a port dedicated to a single VLAN and designed for end devices such as PCs, printers, IP phones, or access points. Unlike uplink or trunk ports, which carry multiple VLANs between switches or routers, access ports carry traffic for a single VLAN, ensuring proper segmentation and network security.

VLAN Configuration

When connecting an access point, the switch port should be configured to match the VLAN used for the wireless network. For example, a corporate SSID might map to VLAN 10, while a guest SSID could map to VLAN 20. Some access points support multiple SSIDs, in which case the switch port may need to be configured as a trunk port to carry multiple VLANs from the AP to the switch.

Power over Ethernet (PoE)

Many access points require PoE to operate, which allows the switch to provide both data connectivity and electrical power over the same Ethernet cable. Managed switches often support PoE and allow configuration of power allocation per port, which is essential for APs deployed in ceilings or walls where separate power sources are unavailable.
