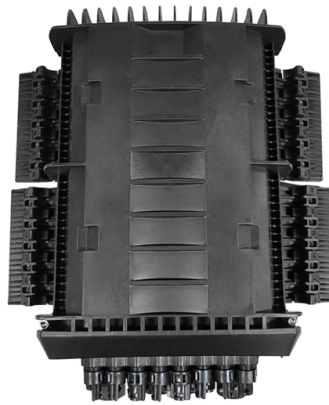


What is a DCPN in a distribution box

Function

- **Isolation:** DCPN ensures that both the live and neutral lines are disconnected, preventing accidental current flow during maintenance or fault conditions.
- **Changeover Capability:** In some installations, it allows switching between two power sources, such as main supply and backup generator, without leaving the neutral line connected incorrectly.
- **Safety Enhancement:** By controlling both poles, it reduces the risk of electric shock and ensures compliance with electrical safety standards.
