

What is a data optical cable

A data optical cable, also known as a fiber-optic cable, transmits data as pulses of light through strands of glass or plastic, enabling high-speed, long-distance communication.

What It Is

A data optical cable is a type of cable designed to carry information using light signals instead of electrical signals. Each cable contains one or more optical fibers, which are thin strands of ultra-pure glass or plastic, typically no thicker than a human hair, that guide light from a transmitter to a receiver with minimal loss .

Structure

A typical optical cable has several layers:

- Core: The central part where light travels, made of ultra-pure glass or plastic .
- Cladding: Surrounds the core and has a slightly different refractive index, reflecting light back into the core to maintain signal strength .
- Buffer/Coating: A protective layer that cushions the fiber and prevents damage .
- Outer Jacket: The tough external layer that shields the cable from moisture, abrasion, and environmental hazards. Some cables include additional armor for outdoor or undersea use .
