

What is a fiber optic home router

What It Is

A fiber optic router is a router specifically built to handle fiber internet connections, such as Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) services provided by ISPs like Google Fiber, Verizon, or Xfinity . Unlike traditional routers that work with DSL or cable connections, a fiber router is designed to fully utilize the high speeds and low latency of fiber-optic networks . It connects to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the fiber-optic signal into Ethernet that the router can distribute to your devices .

How It Works

Fiber internet transmits data as pulses of light through optical fibers, allowing for extremely fast speeds and minimal interference . The ONT acts like a modem, translating the optical signal into a format the router can use. The fiber router then distributes this connection via wired Ethernet or Wi-Fi to your home devices. Using a standard router without fiber support may limit your network speed, creating a bottleneck that prevents you from taking full advantage of your fiber connection .

- **Low Latency:** Fiber routers reduce lag, which is crucial for online gaming and video conferencing .
