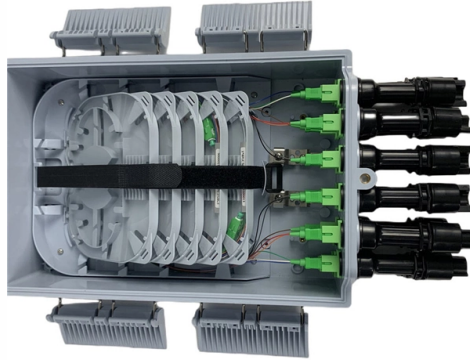

Structure

The patch cord consists of several layers:

- Core: Made of glass or plastic, it carries the light signal. Single-mode cores are typically 9 μm in diameter, while multi-mode cores are 50-62.5 μm .
- Cladding: Surrounds the core and reflects light back into it, minimizing signal loss .
- Strength Members: Usually aramid yarn (Kevlar) to provide durability without compromising flexibility .
- Protective Jacket: Shields the fiber from physical damage and environmental factors .
