

What is the center dimension of the cable tray

The center dimension of a cable tray typically refers to the internal width between the side rails, which ranges from 50 mm to 1000 mm (2 inches to 36 inches) depending on application and cable load.

Understanding Cable Tray Width

The center dimension, or internal width, is the primary factor that determines how many cables can be installed safely. Standard widths vary based on the type of installation:

- Narrow trays (50–150 mm / 2–6 inches): Used for instrumentation, control wiring, or small data lines where cable counts are low and space is limited .
- Medium trays (300–600 mm / 12–24 inches): Suitable for general power distribution in commercial buildings and light industrial applications, balancing cable capacity and structural economy .
- Wide trays (>600 mm / 24–36 inches): Designed for heavy industrial installations, data centers, or utility projects with large bundles of power or fiber optic cables . The usable width is measured from the inside of one side rail to the other, not including the thickness of the rails themselves. This ensures proper cable fill, heat dissipation, and compliance with electrical codes, which typically limit cable fill to 50% for power circuits in a single layer .
