

What is the maximum number of circuits in a lighting distribution box

Determining Circuit Capacity

The total number of circuits a lighting distribution box can accommodate is influenced by several factors:

- **Box Size and Terminals:** Distribution boxes are designed with a specific number of ways or terminals for outgoing circuits. For example, a dual control/supply lighting box may handle two independent groups of luminaires, with expansion possible via additional plug-in boxes . Larger boxes can support more circuits, often 12-way or 18-way configurations .
- **Protective Devices:** Each circuit requires its own protective device, such as an MCB, RCBO, or fuse. The box must have sufficient space and busbar capacity to accommodate these devices safely .
- **Load Considerations:** The total load of all lighting circuits must not exceed the box's rated current. For residential lighting, a 15-Amp branch circuit typically serves 600 ft², while a 20-Amp circuit can serve 800 ft² . The number of circuits is calculated based on total lighting load and the amperage of each circuit.
- **Code Compliance:** Electrical codes like the NEC in the U.S. or the CEC in Canada dictate box fill limits, neutral separation, and grounding requirements. Overcrowding a box can lead to overheating and safety hazards .
