Overview

ODF typically contains several ports or slots into which fiber optic cables can be plugged. Due to the rise in High Density ODFs can come between 24 ports, 48 ports, or even up to 144 ports as standard. The primary function of an ODF is to distribute optical signals from one cable. A fiber optic distribution box — also known as an FDB or NAP (Network Access Point) — is a mid-span enclosure that distributes fibers from a feeder cable to individual drop cables serving subscribers or building floors.
