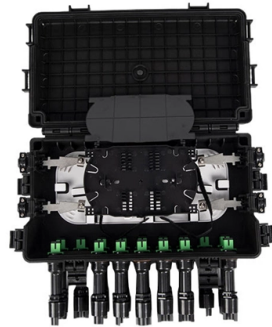

Remote Radio Units (RRUs) are deployed near antennas to handle radio signal transmission and reception, converting digital signals from the Baseband Unit (BBU) into RF signals and vice versa. To connect RRUs to BBUs, high-speed optical modules are used over fiber optic links, ensuring low latency and reliable communication .

Types of Optical Modules

- 1.25G optical modules – suitable for lower-capacity links or short distances.
- 2.5G optical modules – standard for medium-capacity RRU-BBU connections.
- 6G optical modules – used for higher throughput requirements.
- 10G optical modules – for high-capacity or aggregated RRU connections . These modules are typically SFP or SFP+ form factors, compatible with single-mode fiber (OS2) for long-distance transmission.
