Power over Ethernet switch (or PoE switch) is an access layer technology that combines data signals and electrical power into a single Ethernet cable connection, delivering both to enable a powered device (PD). It enables one RJ45 patch cable to provide both a data connection and electric power to connected. In this configuration, an Ethernet connection includes Power over Ethernet (PoE) (gray cable looping below), and a PoE splitter provides a separate data cable (gray, looping above) and power cable (black, also looping above) for a wireless access point.
