Core and Cladding Interface

The fiber core inside the connector is usually made of ultra-pure silica glass (SiO_2), sometimes doped with germanium or phosphorus to adjust the refractive index for optimal light transmission. The surrounding cladding is also silica-based but may be doped with fluorine or boron to create a lower refractive index, ensuring total internal reflection and minimal signal loss during transmission .

Ferrules

The ferrule is the critical component that aligns the fiber within the connector. Ferrules are commonly made from:

- Ceramic (zirconia): Offers high precision and durability, ideal for high-performance applications.
- Metal (stainless steel or nickel-plated brass): Provides mechanical strength and stability.
- Plastic (polymer-based): Used in lower-cost or less demanding applications, offering flexibility and ease of manufacturing .
