

What size support is best for cable trays



Overview

What is the standard support spacing for cable trays?

Support spacing typically ranges from 1 to 3 meters depending on tray type, load, and material. Does heavy cable load require shorter support spacing?

Yes. Cable tray supports provide all of the structural support required for the cable trays, and they can be assembled in a number of configurations as required for the particular installation. Unlike a simple wire trough, which is typically a covered channel for shorter runs, cable trays provide a comprehensive support system for complex wiring paths over long. Cable tray support spacing refers to the distance between tray support points such as brackets, hangers, wall supports, or floor-mounted structures. Support spacing is usually measured in meters or feet. The safety of your people and the reliability of your electrical system depend on proper cable tray support spacing. 0 m depending on tray type and load. Common values: 200, 400, 600, 800mm Actual height of the cable tray.
