

What size wire should be used for the main distribution box panel

The wire size for a main distribution panel depends on the panel's amperage rating, with 2/0 AWG copper or 4/0 AWG aluminum typically used for a 200-amp service.

Determining Wire Size

The correct wire size is primarily determined by the amperage rating of the main panel, the conductor material, and the installation method:

- 200-amp service: Use 2/0 AWG copper or 4/0 AWG aluminum for the service entrance cable from the meter to the panel, following NEC Table 310.16 and considering voltage drop for longer runs .
- 100-amp service: Typically requires #4 AWG copper or #2 AWG aluminum.
- Larger commercial panels (400-600 amps): Require proportionally larger conductors, often 500 kcmil copper or 750 kcmil aluminum, depending on load calculations and NEC guidelines .

Conductor Material and Insulation

- Copper: Higher conductivity, smaller size for the same amperage, more expensive.
- Aluminum: Lower cost, larger size required, must use antioxidant paste at connections to prevent corrosion.
- Insulation types: THHN/THWN-2 is common for indoor conduit installations; USE-2 or SE cables are used for direct burial or outdoor service entrance
