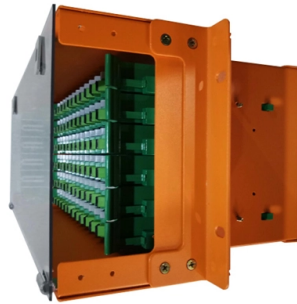


What to do when fiber optic cable enters the fiber optic splice box
