

What type of network cable is needed for a PoE switch

For PoE switches, Cat5e or higher Ethernet cables are recommended, with Cat6 or Cat6a preferred for higher power and future-proofing.

Recommended Cable Categories

- Cat5: Minimum requirement for basic PoE (802.3af) and PoE+ (802.3at), but not recommended for higher-power 802.3bt applications due to limited performance and shielding .
- Cat5e: Meets the minimum requirements for all PoE standards, including 802.3bt, and is suitable for most standard installations .
- Cat6: Strongly recommended for optimal performance, supporting higher data rates, better interference protection, and higher power delivery for 802.3bt .
- Cat6a and above: Ideal for future-proofing, supporting higher speeds, longer distances, and high-wattage PoE applications .
- Cat7/Cat8: Used in advanced or high-performance networks requiring maximum data rates and minimal interference, though often overkill for typical PoE deployments .

Key Considerations

- Cable Quality: Use high-quality copper cables; avoid Copper Clad Aluminum (CCA) as it can overheat and reduce reliability .
