Connect the Main Ground Wire: Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire of appropriate cross-section (typically 6 mm² internationally or 10 AWG in the US). Strip the wire end, insert it into the PE bar or grounding terminal, and tighten the screw firmly to ensure a reliable connection .

Ground Electrical Components: Any internal components that require grounding should be connected to the PE bar using copper wires. This ensures that all metallic parts are at the same potential, reducing the risk of electric shock or equipment damage .

Verify Grounding Quality: The total ground resistance should be low (typically
