- **Turn Off Power:** Always shut off the circuit at the breaker or disconnect the battery in automotive applications. Verify the circuit is de-energized using a voltage tester .
- **Prepare the Wires:** Strip about 0.5-0.75 inches of insulation from the ends of the main wires and the pigtail wire. Twist stranded wires to prevent fraying .
- **Connect the Pigtail to Main Wires:** Use a wire nut to join the pigtail wire with the corresponding main wires (hot to hot, neutral to neutral, ground to ground). Ensure a tight, secure connection .
- **Attach the Pigtail to the Device:** Insert the free end of the pigtail into the device's terminal screw or connector. For outlets and switches, this isolates the device from the main circuit, maintaining power to downstream devices even if the device fails .
