- **Servers and Storage Devices** In data centers, patch cords connect servers or storage arrays to switches or SANs (Storage Area Networks) for high-speed optical communication .

Key Considerations

- **Connector Type:** Ensure the patch cord's connector (LC, SC, ST, MPO) matches the device port .
