- **Fiber to ONT:** The fiber optic cable from your ISP enters your home and connects to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT). The ONT converts the light signals into electrical signals compatible with standard networking equipment.
- **ONT to Router:** From the ONT, a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) connects to your router's WAN port. This step is necessary because most consumer routers do not have a direct fiber input.
- **Direct Fiber Input:** Only routers with an SFP or SFP+ port designed for fiber can accept a fiber optic cable directly. Even then, the correct module must match your ISP's protocol (e.g., GPON or XGPON) to function properly.
