

Which is better an access gateway or a switch

Key Differences

Switch:

- Operates primarily at Layer 2 (Data Link Layer), with some Layer 3 switches adding routing capabilities .
- Connects devices within the same network (LAN), directing data only to the intended device using MAC addresses .
- Reduces network collisions and improves efficiency by creating separate collision domains for each device .
- Best for fast, local communication between computers, printers, and servers in offices or data centers .
- Typically plug-and-play, requiring minimal configuration .

Gateway:

- Operates at Layer 3 (Network Layer) or higher, translating data between different networks or protocols .
- Connects a local network to external networks, such as a home LAN to the Internet .
- Can provide security features like firewalls, NAT, and VPN support .
