- Choose the connector that matches your equipment ports to avoid compatibility issues.

3. Polish Type:

- UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) polish provides low insertion loss and moderate return loss, making it suitable for most indoor and data center applications.
- Avoid mixing UPC with APC connectors, as they are not compatible and can cause high signal loss.
