

# Wiring layout for the suite s electrical distribution box



## Summary of Content

A suite's electrical distribution box should be wired with a main breaker, individual circuit breakers for each load, and properly connected live, neutral, and earth wires following safety codes.

### Key Components of the Distribution Box

- **Main Breaker:** Controls the entire electrical supply to the suite and allows complete disconnection during maintenance or emergencies ( ).
- **Circuit Breakers:** Protect individual circuits from overcurrent and short circuits. Single-pole (1P) breakers control one phase, while double-pole (2P) breakers control both live and neutral lines for higher voltage appliances ( ).
- **Bus Bars:** Include neutral and ground bars where neutral (N) and protective earth (PE) wires are connected ( ).
- **Protective Devices:** Residual Current Devices (RCDs) or surge protectors provide additional safety against earth faults and voltage spikes ( ).

### Wiring Layout Guidelines

- **Live (L) Wire Connection:** Connect the incoming live wire from the main supply to the line terminal of the main breaker. From there, branch it to individual circuit breakers ( ).
- **Neutral (N) Wire Connection:** For 1P breakers, the neutral bypasses the breaker and connects directly to the neutral bus bar. For 2P breakers, both live and neutral wires pass through the breaker ( ).
