

Wiring method for secondary construction site power distribution boxes

Secondary distribution boxes on construction sites are designed to safely distribute power from primary distribution boxes to temporary site equipment, incorporating isolation, circuit protection, and leakage safeguards.

Overview of Secondary Distribution Boxes

A secondary distribution box receives power from a primary distribution box and supplies electricity to temporary construction equipment, lighting, and auxiliary socket panels. These boxes are specifically designed for the construction environment, featuring rainproof enclosures, inner and outer doors, and durable materials suitable for field conditions (). They form part of a three-level protection system, ensuring that each machine or circuit has dedicated isolation and protection.

Wiring and Configuration

- **Incoming Power:** The secondary box is connected to the primary distribution box via a dedicated power line. It typically includes three-phase power, neutral, and ground connections ().
- **Circuit Protection:**
 - **Main circuit isolation:** A general isolation switch allows the entire secondary box to be disconnected from the primary supply.
 - **Main circuit fuse and breaker:** Protects the box from overloads and short circuits.
