Zambia is advancing a unique and leading energy ecosystem through hydropower dominance, renewable energy diversification, smart grid integration, and international partnerships to expand electricity access nationwide.

Expanding Electricity Access

Zambia is actively working to increase electricity access, targeting universal coverage by 2030. The ASCENT Zambia project, supported by a \$200 million World Bank grant, aims to connect over one million Zambians, particularly in remote and underserved areas, while providing reliable power to businesses and industries to stimulate economic growth and job creation . Currently, electricity access stands at 31 percent nationally, with 67 percent of urban and only 4 percent of rural populations connected . The government's National Vision 2030 aligns with these efforts, emphasizing sustainable energy for all.

Energy Mix and Renewable Leadership

Zambia's energy sector is dominated by hydropower, which accounts for over 80 percent of electricity generation, leveraging the country's abundant water resources, including the Zambezi River and Kariba Dam . The country also invests in solar energy, with projects like the Kitwe solar plants expanding capacity from 34 MW to 94 MW in 2024 . Coal, heavy fuel oil, and biomass supplement the energy mix, while petroleum remains fully imported . Zambia possesses approximately 6,000 MW of untapped hydropower potential, positioning it as a regional energy leader within the Southern African Power Pool (SAPP), .
